Committees**

Bench and Bar Committee – deals with issues of common interest to the Bar and Polk County District Court. Issues may include procedures or broader issues on the administration of justice.

CLE Committee – plans CLE seminars of the Bar.

Family Law Committee – deals with issues relating to family law, including any needed revisions in the existing family law justice system which can be addressed on a local level.

Fee Arbitration Committee – hears disputes between attorneys and clients, primarily regarding fees. Membership on this committee is by recommendation of the Nominating Committee (past presidents) and by approval of the Board of Directors.

Ethics Committee – reviews complaints against attorneys to determine if the attorneys violated any ethical rules. Membership on this committee is by recommendation of the Nominating Committee (past presidents) and by election of the membership only.

Law Day Committee – plans activities for the observance of Law Day.

Membership Committee – encourages and recruits attorneys for membership; develops ideas and events to promote membership.

Newsletter Committee – publishes the PCBA newsletter "The Advocate".

Publicity/Public Relations – publicizes the activities of the Association, educates the public as to what we do, and deals with public relations issues.

Social Committee – plans the annual Bench/Bar golf event and other social events for the bar.

Real Estate Committee – deals with a special range of issues involving real estate law and title standards.

PCBA YLD – provides social networking and CLE opportunities for Young Lawyers.
