Consider Joining a PCBA Committee

Bench and Bar Committee – plans events particularly about issues of common interest to the Bar and Polk County District Court. Issues may include procedures or broader issues on the administration of justice and related event and CLE planning.

CLE Committee – plans two annual full-day CLE seminars for members.

Family Law Committee – specialized in issues relating to family law, including any needed revisions in the existing family law justice system which can be addressed on a local level.

Fee Arbitration Committee – hears disputes between attorneys and clients, primarily regarding fees. Membership on this committee is by recommendation of the Nominating Committee (past presidents) and by approval of the Board of Directors.

Golf Committee – plans the annual Bench and Bar Golf Outing and related events. The goal of the golf outing is to raise funds for the Polk County Bar Association Volunteer Lawyers Project by soliciting sponsorships and other donations.

In-House-Practice Committee - offers CLEs, networking opportunities and discussions of needs and interests that are unique to in-house counsel attorneys.

Law Day Committee – plans activities for the observance of Law Day.

Membership Committee – encourages and recruits attorneys for PCBA membership; develops ideas and events to promote membership. Develops ideas and hosts events to promote membership and participation within the Bar Association. Works to inform and educate the general public about the roles attorneys play in the community and the various services attorneys provide.

Small Firm/Solo Practice Committee - offers CLEs and discussions of needs and interests that are unique to solo and small firm practices.
