Unless otherwise specified, Holiday / Birthday parenting time set out above shall be from 9 AM until 9 AM the following day and shall take precedence over regularly scheduled weekend or weeknight parenting time.

Christmas / Winter Break. The parties agree to divide the children's Christmas/Winter Break from school as follows:

Even Years: Father will have the kids beginning the afternoon school is dismissed for Christmas Break and his visitation will continue for the first half of the holiday break. Mother will have the kids the second half of the holiday break. The exception to this schedule will be made for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day which is governed by the next sections.

Father will have the kids Christmas Eve until 9:00 p.m. Mother will have the kids from 9:00 p.m. Christmas Eve until 5:00 p.m. on Christmas Day.

Odd Years: The schedule shall alternate.

Summer Parenting Time. Both parents shall enjoy up extended parenting time with the children each summer. Said parenting time may be exercised in two one (1) one-week periods each summer. Extended summer parenting time shall not interfere with the holiday schedule provided for herein.

For scheduling purposes, in even numbered years Mother shall designate (in writing to Father) the weeks she intends to exercise his extended summer parenting time (if any) on or before April 1st. Thereafter, Father shall designate (in writing to Mother the weeks (if any) he intends to exercise his extended summer parenting time on or before May 1st. In odd numbered years, Father shall designate summer parenting time first (by April 1st) and Mother by May 1st.
