**In the Matter of Amendments to
the Iowa Court Rules on Attorney
Oath and Admissions**


The Iowa Supreme Court approves amendments to the Iowa Court Rules creating a uniform procedure for applicants approved for admission to practice law in Iowa to petition for submission of a written oath or affirmation in lieu of appearing in person before an Iowa Supreme Court justice for administration of the attorney's oath or affirmation.

The amended rules adopted and provided with this order take effect April 1, 2022.

The court's March 19, 2020 order suspending rules 31.1(2)(d), 31.4(6), 31.13(1)(c), and 31.13(2) during implementation of Covid-related processes is superseded by the court's December 6, 2021 order and adoption of the rule amendments contained in the instant order.
