3. Cristina C. - dissolution of marriage - Parties have participated in mediation and have signed a mediation settlement agreement. Client speaks Spanish. We will provide an interpreter.
4. Blanca G. – dissolution of marriage – no minor children, no joint property or debts. Client speaks Spanish. We will provide an interpreter.
5. Daniel K. – dissolution of marriage - no minor children, no property or debts.
6. Fanny F. – dissolution of marriage – 3 children, whereabouts of OP unknown. There was domestic violence of OP against client. Spanish speaking. We'll provide interpreter.
8. Shelley C. - dissolution of marriage - no children, no joint property or debts.
10. GAL for person incarcerated in Mitchellville. She is the respondent in a paternity, custody, visitation and child support modification case. A one-day bench trial is scheduled for Aug. 1, 2022. Petitioner is pro se. The court wrote that a GAL for her is needed.
14. GAL for incarcerated persons – For number 2. on this list we would like to have volunteer guardian ad litem for the incarcerated respondent in the divorce case.
15. Bernardita M. – custody – custody order for her 6 year old child. Bio Dad got deported in 2017. His whereabouts are unknown. Client states bio Dad was very abusive towards her. Client speaks Spanish, we will provide an interpreter.
16. Connie B. – Conservatorship – Client needs conservatorship done for her disabled daughter. She already has guardianship. Client wants to open a trust account for her daughter with insurance money that she will receive because her father passed away.
17. Lori J. – Taxes – client owes back taxes to the State of Iowa. Her only income is Soc. Sec. She is interested in setting up a payment plan. She contacted IA Dept. of Revenue but the payments they offered her are too high.
18. Russell F. – Probate – Client's Mom passed away this January. Her name is on the title of the house where client lives. Mom had a will and is leaving the house to client in the will. There are no other assets.
19. Billie M. – Landlord/Tenant – Landlord refusing to refund her deposit.
20. Ericka A. – Quit claim deed - client wanted to add her children to her deed, because she is ill. She filled out a quit claim deed without her name. Now she is not on the deed at all. She wants to be on the deed together with her children.
21. Kaylia B. – Contractor Issue – Client refinanced her mortgage for a renovation. The contractor has received more than \$16,000 from the lender but has completed little work and has not paid his subcontractors and one has placed a mechanic's lien on client's home.
22. Antoinette M. – advanced directives – client want health care & general POA.
